Covering Seven Leading English Newspapers:

Business Recorder, Daily Times, Dawn, Financial Times, Pakistan Observer,
The Express Tribune, The Nation, and The News

SUMMARY

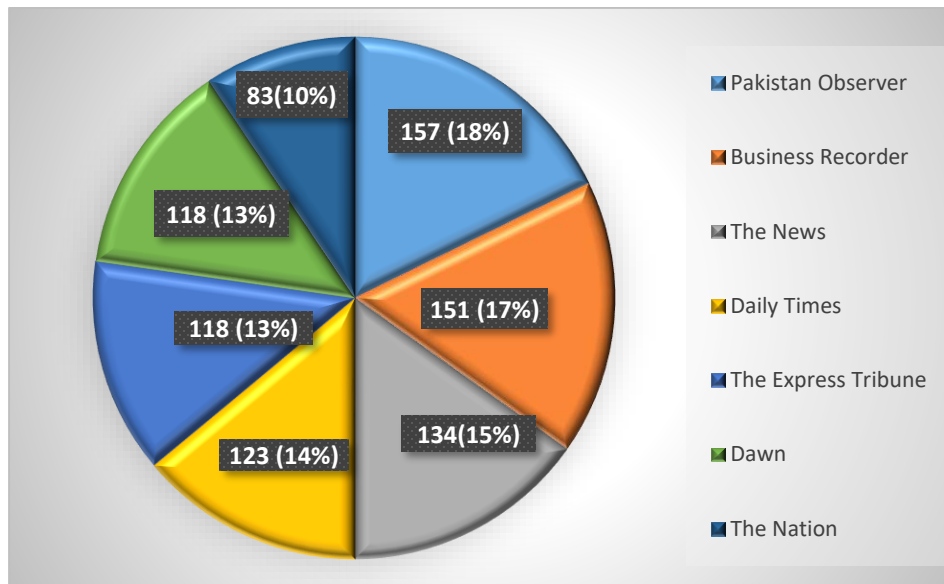


Figure 1: Selected seven newspapers and their number of entries included in the index

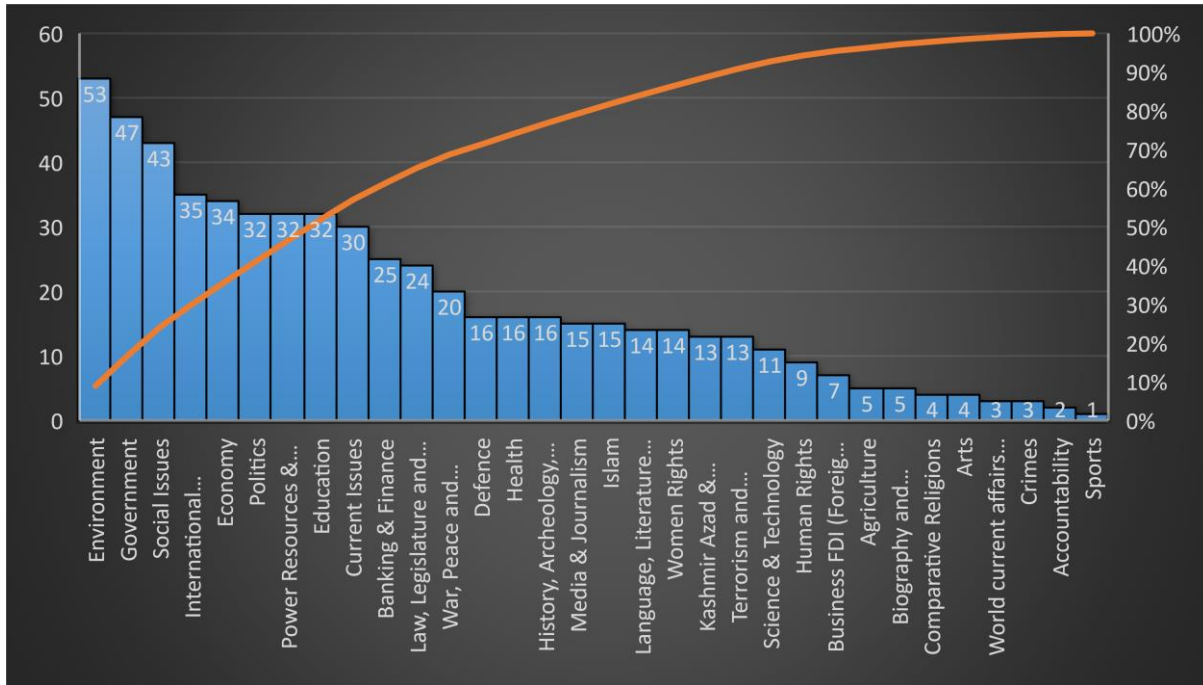


Figure 2: Newspapers coverage on various topics at national level

This newspaper index report highlights editorial coverage trends in seven prominent Pakistani newspapers (*Pakistan Observer*, *The News*, *Business Recorder*, *Daily Times*, *Dawn*, *The Express Tribune*, and *The Nation*) during the month of July 2025. The report is divided into three sections: national-level editorial coverage, international-level coverage, and a combined overview of topics, with a minimum occurrence threshold of 15 entries per subject to ensure significance. A total of 884 editorial articles were indexed across the seven English-language newspapers (Figure 1). The data indicates that 32 national topics and 23 international topics were covered (Figures 2 and 3). However, applying the threshold of a minimum of 15 mentions, the analysis reveals a stronger editorial focus on domestic issues, 17 national topics met this criterion, compared to six international topics (Figure 4).

At the **national level**, prominent topics included *Environment* (53 entries), *Government* (47 entries), *Social Issues* (43 entries), *International Relations* (35 entries), *Economy* (34 entries), *Politics* (32 entries), *Power and Natural Resources* (32 entries), *Education* (32 entries), *Current Issues* (30 entries), *Banking and Finance* (25 entries), *Law, Legislature and Judiciary* (24 entries), *War, Peace and Security* (20 entries), *Defence* (16 entries), *Health* (16 entries), *History, Archaeology, Geography, and Travel* (16 entries), *Media and Journalism* (15 entries), *Islam* (15 entries) and others. This national trends shows a multi-layered discourse, where environmental issues, governance, social challenges, and economic development dominate, but with continued resonance of security, regional conflicts, and political contestations. On the **international front**, *The United States* (43 entries), *OIC, Islamic World Conflicts, and West vs Muslim World theme* (42 entries), *India* (40 entries), *China* (24 entries), *World International Relations and Foreign Policies* (18 entries), *World Politics* (17 entries) and others.

Overall, these trends suggest that Pakistan's press in July 2025 was deeply preoccupied with two intertwined layers of reality: (1) national crises of governance, economy, and environment that impact daily life, and (2) global conflicts and alliances that directly affect Pakistan's security and foreign policy. The balance between local vulnerabilities and global shifts reflects a media narrative that is both inward-looking and outwardly cautious, positioning Pakistan as a nation caught between its internal struggles and the uncertainties of an unstable world order.

Newspapers’ and Their Number of Entries

The editorial report of seven major Pakistani newspapers in English language provides trends and patterns publishing in these selected newspapers (**Data attached as Annexure – I**). In July 2025, a total of 884 editorial articles were indexed across seven prominent Pakistani English-language newspapers (Table 1). It shows that Pakistan Observer 157 (18%) contributed the highest number of indexed items, closely followed by Business Recorder 151 (17%) and The News 134 (15%). Together, these three newspapers account for half of the overall coverage, indicating their significant role in disseminating information to the public. The Daily Times 123 (14%), Dawn 118 (13%) and The Express Tribune 118 (13%) also hold a notable share, showing that they remain influential sources, though slightly behind the top three. Meanwhile, The Nation accounts for the smallest proportion 83 (10%), suggesting relatively limited coverage compared to its counterparts.

Newspapers Editorial Coverage at National Level

The indexed newspaper’s editorial entries provide a comprehensive overview of the topics covered in the Pakistani context, highlighting the diversity of issues addressed across seven major newspapers (Data attached as Annexure – I). Overall, it covers 32 various topics at national level in these seven Pakistani newspapers in English language (Figure 2).

The July 2025 coverage of national topics in Pakistani newspapers reflects a diverse and dynamic focus on issues that shape the country’s socio-political and developmental discourse. At the forefront is *Environment* (53 entries), indicating the growing recognition of climate change, natural disasters, and environmental degradation as pressing challenges for Pakistan. The prominence of this theme suggests heightened awareness in both policy and public debates around ecological sustainability. Close behind, *Government* (47 entries) and *Social Issues* (43 entries) reveal continued scrutiny of governance structures and societal challenges. Coverage in these areas highlights the public’s demand for accountability, transparency, and attention to everyday struggles such as poverty, inequality, ethics, values, and civic well-being. Similarly, *International Relations* (35 entries) and *Economy* (34 entries) underscore Pakistan’s balancing act between domestic needs and global engagements, where economic resilience, foreign policy alignments, and trade remain central themes. Interestingly, *Politics* (32 entries), *Power and Natural Resources* (32 entries), and *Education* (32 entries) appear with equal emphasis. This clustering suggests that politics in various political parties in Pakistan (especially about the PTI), solar energy, nature resources, water crises and mismanagement, and educational reforms are seen as interconnected pillars of national stability and progress. Coverage of *Current Issues* (30 entries) further demonstrates newspapers’ responsiveness to emerging debates, from policy reforms to immediate socio-political developments.

Mid-tier themes such as *Banking and Finance* (25 entries), *Law, Legislature and Judiciary* (24 entries), *War, Peace and Security* (20 entries), and *Defence* (16 entries) continue to show the relevance of economic governance and institutional frameworks while also reminding readers of Pakistan's underlying security concerns. Notably, *Health* (16 entries) and *History, Archaeology, Geography, and Travel* (16 entries) reflect both practical needs like healthcare access and cultural-historical awareness, indicating newspapers' multidimensional role in shaping identity. Among the emerging voices, *Media and Journalism* (15 entries) and *Islam* (15 entries) signal attention to freedom of press, religious discourse, and cultural narratives. Social dimensions such as *Women's Rights* (14 entries) and *Language, Literature, and Rhetoric* (14 entries) suggest evolving conversations around equity, representation, and cultural identity. Meanwhile, *Kashmir* (13 entries) and *Terrorism and Extremism* (13 entries) highlight Pakistan's continued entanglement with regional disputes and security threats. Relatively lower coverage of *Science and Technology* (11 entries), *Human Rights* (9 entries), and *FDI* (7 entries) indicates that while these topics are important, they struggle to gain sustained visibility amid dominant political, social, and environmental narratives. Even more marginal are *Agriculture* (5 entries), *Biography and Autobiography* (5 entries), and softer themes such as *Arts* (4 entries), *Comparative Religions* (4 entries), *Sports* (1 entry), and *Crimes* (3 entries). Their limited presence suggests a continuing prioritization of structural, political, and security-driven themes over cultural or lifestyle-oriented topics.

Overall, the July 2025 coverage reveals a multi-layered discourse, where environmental issues, governance, social challenges, and economic development dominate, but with continued resonance of security, regional conflicts, and political contestations. The distribution of themes suggests that Pakistani newspapers are increasingly acknowledging the urgency of sustainability and social reform, while also remaining grounded in the nation's political realities and security anxieties.

Newspaper Editorial Coverage at Global Level

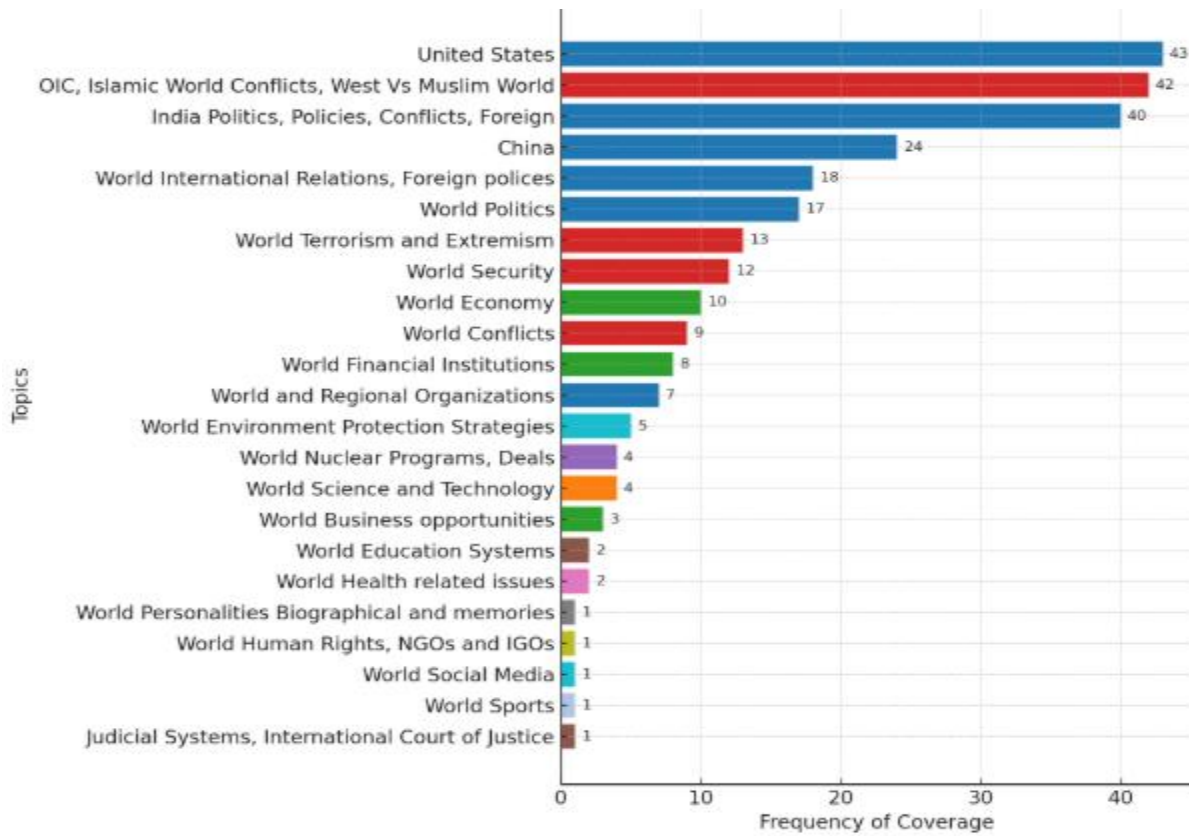


Figure 3: Global coverage areas or topics in Pakistani English newspapers

The international-level coverage across the indexed newspapers provides a detailed insight into the global focus and priorities reflected in the media. Overall, there are 23 various topics have been covered at global level in these seven Pakistani newspapers in English language (Figure 3). In July 2025, the editorial focus of seven Pakistani English newspapers strongly centered on the role of the United States of America, West verse Islamic World issues (especially related to the Gaza genocide), and Indian's government extremist policies and conflicts.

The global coverage trends in July 2025 reveal a sharp concentration on geopolitical and security-related issues, underscoring how Pakistani newspapers continue to mirror the country’s international concerns and align them with national sensitivities. The *United States* (43 entries) tops the list, primarily because of President Trump’s active involvement in commenting on South Asian affairs. His continued appreciation of Pakistan’s civil–military leadership, alongside his frequent criticisms of India’s Prime Minister Modi, has kept U.S.–Pakistan–India relations at the center of discourse. Almost equally prominent is the *OIC, Islamic World Conflicts, and West vs Muslim World theme* (42 entries), which is mainly tied to the ongoing Israeli genocide against Palestinians, particularly targeting children and women. The coverage highlights the OIC’s inability to produce meaningful interventions and the broader international community’s silence, framing this tragedy not only as a humanitarian disaster but also as a destabilizing factor for global peace and Muslim solidarity. Coverage of *India* (40 entries) remains consistent, emphasizing its aggressive policies and conflicts, both domestically and internationally. Pakistan’s press continues to view Indian politics as central to regional instability. Meanwhile, *China* (24 entries) is portrayed as an emerging strategic partner for Pakistan, not only in defense cooperation but also in strengthening bilateral ties in trade and development.

Beyond these dominant actors, coverage of global governance and diplomacy such as *World International Relations and Foreign Policies* (18 entries), *World Politics* (17 entries), and *World Security* (12 entries), reflects growing concerns over global instability, particularly shaped by the Russian–Ukrainian war and shifting global alliances. These issues are often linked to the broader discussion of *world conflicts* (9 entries), indicating a recognition that multiple regions face turbulence simultaneously. In terms of structural concerns, topics like *World Financial Institutions* (8 entries), *World and Regional Organizations* (7 entries), and *World Nuclear Programs* (4 entries) show that Pakistani media remains aware of how institutional frameworks and power blocs shape the international order. However, issues such as *environmental strategies* (5 entries), *science and technology* (4 entries), and *health* (2 entries) receive minimal attention, signaling that while climate change and global health crises are urgent, they are overshadowed by immediate political and security discourses.

Overall, the global news coverage demonstrates world crisis, one where power struggles, wars, and humanitarian injustices dominate headlines, while longer-term developmental and human issues remain underrepresented.

Major Publishing Trends (combing both National and Global) in Pakistani Newspapers

Based on the application of the 15-occurrence threshold (combining local and international subjects), 23 topics meeting the minimum frequency threshold of 15; 17 entries pertain to national contexts and six from the international context (Figure 4).

On the national front, a diverse set of 17 themes emerged, reflecting the complexity of Pakistan's socio-political landscape. The Environment (53 entries) received the highest attention, a striking indicator of how climate change, floods, heatwaves, and natural resource mismanagement have become unavoidable realities shaping everyday life. Following this, Government (47 entries) and Social Issues (43 entries) highlight the dual struggle of governance capacity and the lived challenges of ordinary citizens, ranging from inflation and unemployment to inequality and social justice. Economic concerns were never far from the spotlight, with Economy (34 entries), Banking & Finance (25 entries), and Power & Natural Resources (32 entries) dominating discourse. These reflect the continued turbulence of Pakistan's financial system, dependency on international loans, and the recurring crises of energy shortages that affect both households and industries. Side by side, Education (32 entries) and Health (16 entries) show an ongoing recognition of human development needs, though still overshadowed by political and financial instability. In terms of governance and state functioning, Politics (32 entries), Law, Legislature & Judiciary (24 entries), and Defence (16 entries) reveal the underlying institutional tensions, power struggles, and the role of civil–military dynamics. Coverage of Current Issues (30 entries) and History, Archeology, Geography & Travel (16 entries) suggests that newspapers attempted to balance between immediate crises and cultural narratives, offering readers a sense of both urgency and continuity. Media & Journalism (15 entries) also made the threshold, underscoring how the press continues to reflect on its own role in a fragile democracy.

On the international front, six themes qualified, led by the United States (43 entries), which dominated because of President Trump's vocal involvement in South Asian politics, particularly his remarks on India and Pakistan. OIC, Islamic World Conflicts, and West vs Muslim World (42 entries) remained another high-priority issue, largely due to the ongoing humanitarian catastrophe in Palestine and the perceived silence or inaction of Muslim leadership. India (40 entries) continued to receive heavy coverage as Pakistan's closest rival and neighbor, while China (24 entries) stood out as a strategic ally and counterbalance. The broader landscape of global affairs was represented through World International Relations & Foreign Policies (18 entries) and World Politics (17 entries), reflecting how shifting alliances, wars, and conflicts are shaping the international system and directly influencing Pakistan's standing in the world.

Taken together, these trends suggest that Pakistan's press in July 2025 was deeply preoccupied with two intertwined layers of reality: (1) national crises of governance, economy,

and environment that impact daily life, and (2) global conflicts and alliances that directly affect Pakistan's security and foreign policy. The balance between local vulnerabilities and global shifts reflects a media narrative that is both inward-looking and outwardly cautious, positioning Pakistan as a nation caught between its internal struggles and the uncertainties of an unstable world order.
