Covering Seven Leading English Newspapers:

Business Recorder, Daily Times, Dawn, Financial Times, Pakistan Observer,
The Express Tribune, The Nation, and The News

SUMMARY

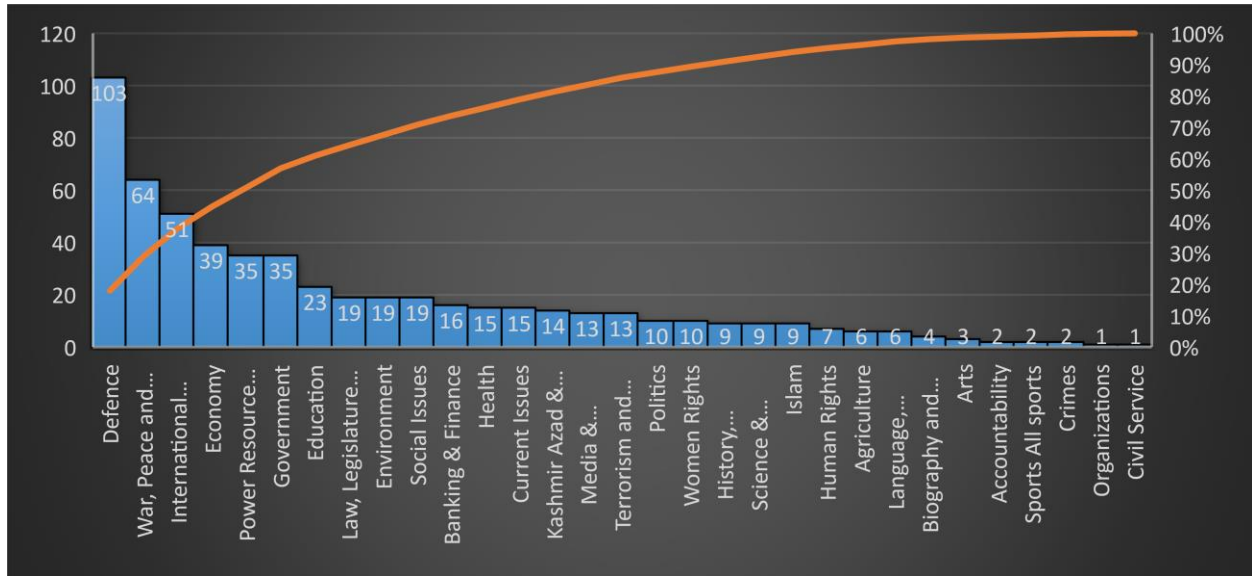


Figure 1: Newspapers coverage on various topics at national level

This newspaper index report highlights editorial coverage trends in seven prominent Pakistani newspapers (*Pakistan Observer*, *The News*, *Business Recorder*, *Daily Times*, *Dawn*, *The Express Tribune*, and *The Nation*) during May 2025. It reflects coverage of a wide range of national and international topics. The report is divided into three sections: national-level editorial coverage, international-level coverage, and a combined overview of topics, with a minimum occurrence threshold of 15 entries per subject to ensure significance. A total of 896 editorial articles were indexed across the seven English-language newspapers (Table 1). The data indicates that 31 national topics and 25 international topics were covered (Figures 1 and 2). However, applying the threshold of a minimum of 15 mentions, the analysis reveals a stronger editorial focus on domestic issues, 13 national topics met this criterion, compared to three international topics (Figure 3).

At the **national level**, prominent topics included *Defense* (103 entries), *War, Peace and Security* (64), *International Relations* (51), *Economy* (39), *Power and Natural Resources* (35), *Government* (35), *Education* (23), *Law, Legislature and Judiciary* (19), *Environment* (19), *Social Issues* (19), *Banking and Finance* (19), *Health* (15), and *Current Issues* (15). On the **international front**, only three topics surpassed the threshold: *Indian Politics, Policies, and Conflicts* (157 entries), *The United States* (40), and *China* (15). This trend reflects heightened editorial attention to the recent Indian attack on Pakistani territory and the role of global powers such as the United States and China in de-escalating tensions between the two nuclear-armed nations.

Overall, the index illustrates how Pakistani print media prioritizes national interests, defense, and geopolitical affairs. The dominant international subject *Indian politics, policies, and conflict* indicates a media narrative critical of the Indian Prime Minister and his party, Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), portraying them as promoting hate, extremism, and regional instability.

Newspapers’ and Their Number of Entries

The editorial report of seven major Pakistani newspapers in English language provides trends and patterns publishing in these selected newspapers (**Data attached as Annexure – I**). In May 2025, a total of 896 editorial articles were indexed across seven prominent Pakistani English-language newspapers (Table 1). The **Pakistan Observer** led in editorial contributions with 166 entries, accounting for 18% of the total coverage. This was followed closely by **The News** (144 entries) and **Business Recorder** (133), both reflecting consistent editorial engagement with current affairs. **Daily Times**, **Dawn**, and **The Express Tribune** each contributed meaningfully, with shares ranging between 125–120 entries, indicating a relatively balanced distribution among mid-tier newspapers. **The Nation**, while still active, had the lowest editorial frequency (94), yet maintained a notable presence in shaping public discourse.

Newspapers Editorial Coverage at National Level

The indexed newspaper’s editorial entries provide a comprehensive overview of the topics covered in the Pakistani context, highlighting the diversity of issues addressed across seven major newspapers (**Data attached as Annexure – I**). Overall, it covers 31 various topics at national level in these seven Pakistani newspapers in English language (Figure 1).

The editorial landscape of Pakistani newspapers in May 2025 exhibited a strong concentration on issues tied to defense, security, and international relations. For example, **Defense** emerged as a top-priority subject with 103 entries, followed by **War, Peace and Security** with 64 entries and **International Relations** with 51 entries. Subjects like **Economy** (39 entries), **Power and Natural Resources**, and **Government** (35 entries each) also featured prominently, highlighting discussions on economy, water issues (specifically Indus water treaty with India), and the role of government to overcome these issues. Meanwhile, **Education** (35 entries) also highlight government importance to align educational institutions with the modern emerging needs such as Artificial Intelligence (AI), skilled based curriculum, character buildings, and implication of anti-harassment policies. ‘**Law, Legislation and Judiciary**’, ‘**Environment**’, and ‘**Social Issues**’, (19 entries each) reflect Pakistan's judicial reforms, legislation, and environmental issues in the region.

The remaining subject received fifteen or less than 15 entries. The subject **Health** and **Current Issues** equally received 15 entries, highlight entries related to tobacco, world immunization day, infectious diseases, etc. Whereas, *Current issues* cover articles related to current India-Pakistan war and nuclear issues, poor road and transportation, and war. **Kashmir**

(Azad and Jammu) received 14 entries (which is also related to recent India-Pakistan war). The presence of **Media and Journalism**, and **Terrorism and Extremism** (13 entries each) underscores the positive role of Pakistani media defusing fake and disinformation at national and global level over the event of India-Pakistan war as well as India promoting terrorist groups operating in Pakistan especially at the Baluchistan territory. The topic **Politics** and **Women Rights** cover equally 10-entries each.

Lesser, yet important, coverage with less than ten article entries were given to **'History, Archeology, Geography'**, **'Science and Technology'**, Islam (9 entries each), followed by **Human Rights** (7 entries), **Agriculture**, **'Language, Literature and Rhetoric'** (6 each entries). Notably underrepresented were **'Biography and Autobiography'** (4 entries), **Arts** (3 entries), **Sports, Crimes, and Accountability (2 entries each)**, and Organization and Civic Services (1 entry each) indicates lesser focus of media-writer of Pakistan. It also revealed that these topics may require more visibility in the editorial sphere to foster a well-rounded national discourse on diverse topics.

Newspaper Editorial Coverage at Global Level

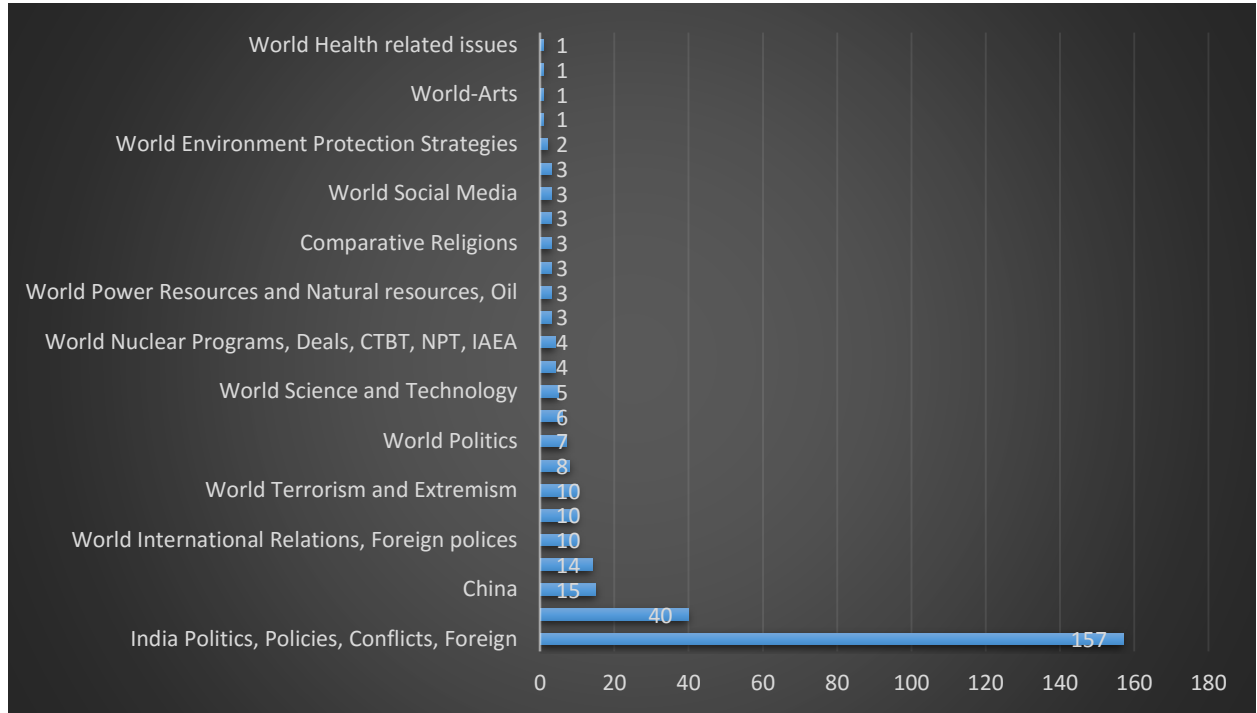


Figure 2: Global coverage areas or topics in Pakistani English newspapers

The international-level coverage across the indexed newspapers provides a detailed insight into the global focus and priorities reflected in the media. Overall, there are 25 various topics have been covered at global level in these seven Pakistani newspapers in English language (Figure 2).

In May 2025, the editorial focus of seven Pakistani English newspapers strongly centered on international affairs, particularly regional tensions and global power dynamics. The most dominant theme was **India's politics, policies, conflicts, and foreign affairs**, with **157 entries**. This overwhelming coverage reflects a deeply critical media narrative towards the Indian government, especially the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and its leadership. The Pakistani press largely portrayed India's ruling party as a source of hatred, extremism, and instability in the region,

highlighting its role in fueling geopolitical tension and deepening divides with neighboring countries, particularly Pakistan. The **United States** followed with 40 entries, maintaining its place as a central actor in global politics. Coverage likely focused on U.S. foreign policy, strategic partnerships, and its role in conflict zones that affect South Asia. **China**, appearing in 15 entries, was covered primarily as a strategic partner of Pakistan and regional counterbalance, especially in light of its economic and diplomatic engagements with Pakistan.

Other globally significant themes included OIC, Islamic world conflicts, and the West-Muslim world divide (14 entries), and discussions on global diplomacy, international relations, security, and terrorism (each with 10 entries). These topics reflect continued editorial concern with the representation of Muslim countries in global politics and the challenges posed by terrorism, war, and global peacekeeping efforts. Subjects such as world conflicts (8), global politics (7), and financial institutions like the IMF and World Bank (6) also gained attention, suggesting awareness of global governance structures and economic dependencies. Meanwhile, emerging issues like science and technology, business opportunities, and nuclear diplomacy appeared in a smaller number of articles (4–5 entries each), showing selective but meaningful engagement with development-oriented topics. Lesser-covered themes included human rights, education systems, power resources, and comparative religions (3 each), pointing to a limited but diverse representation of softer global issues. Other areas like environment, health, arts, and heritage received minimal attention, suggesting they remain on the periphery of editorial priorities in times of heightened political and security discourse.

Overall, the global editorial narrative in May 2025 was dominated by a strong regional lens, heavily critical of India's domestic and foreign conduct, while also keeping a watchful eye

on global powers like the U.S. and China. The coverage reflects a media environment shaped by geopolitical anxieties, ideological divides, and Pakistan’s positioning in a shifting world order.

Major Publishing Trends (combing both National and Global) in Pakistani Newspapers

Based on the application of the 15-occurrence threshold (combining local and international subjects), editorial coverage in seven Pakistani English newspapers during May 2025. Out of the 16 topics meeting the minimum frequency threshold of 15; 13 entries pertain to national contexts and three from the international context. Overall, it reveals a deeply security-focused and politically charged media narrative, reflecting both domestic priorities and regional concerns.

The most dominant theme was India’s politics, policies, conflicts, and foreign affairs, with 157 entries, significantly ahead of all other topics. This reflects an intense media spotlight on India's aggressive posturing and regional behavior, with the tone largely critical of the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and its leadership. The press emphasized narratives of extremism,

human rights violations, and regional destabilization driven by Indian policies, amplified by recent escalations following the Pahalgam incident and heightened cross-border tensions.

On the domestic front, Defense emerged as a critical subject (103 entries), underscoring public and media concern over national security and military preparedness. This was closely followed by War, Peace, and Security (64 entries) and International Relations (51), indicating how internal and external security dynamics were framed as interconnected. The United States (40 entries) and China (15 entries), as key global players, also received significant attention, likely in the context of diplomatic balancing and regional alignments.

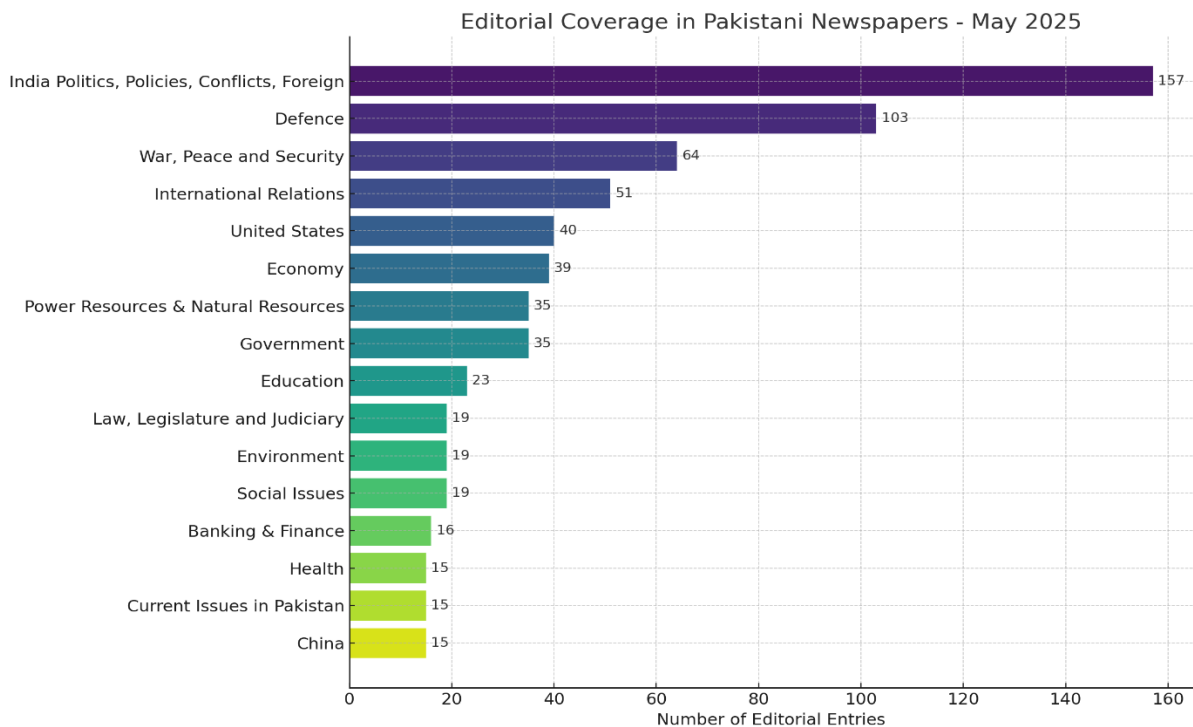


Figure 3: Major publishing trends in Pakistani newspapers (with minimum frequency of 15)

Editorial interest in Economy (39 entries) and Power & Natural Resources (35) highlights concerns over Pakistan’s economic resilience amid inflation, energy shortages, and external dependencies. Similarly, Government (35) was a focus, possibly reflecting criticism or evaluation of governance quality during turbulent times. Education (23 entries), Law and Judiciary (19), and

Environment (19) represent core societal concerns, pointing to growing demands for reforms and sustainability. Social Issues (19) also featured, likely addressing inequality, human rights, and civic unrest, while Banking & Finance (16) signaled interest in financial reforms, investment climate, and monetary policy shifts. Health and Current Issues in Pakistan (15 each) indicate that despite the geopolitical weight of the month's coverage, newspapers still maintained a pulse on public welfare and evolving socio-political developments at home.

Overall, this month's editorial index shows a media landscape dominated by security concerns, national defense, and critical assessments of India's regional role, intertwined with economic challenges and governance debates. While international powers remain in focus, the coverage signals a heightened state of domestic alertness shaped by conflict, strategy, and national identity.
